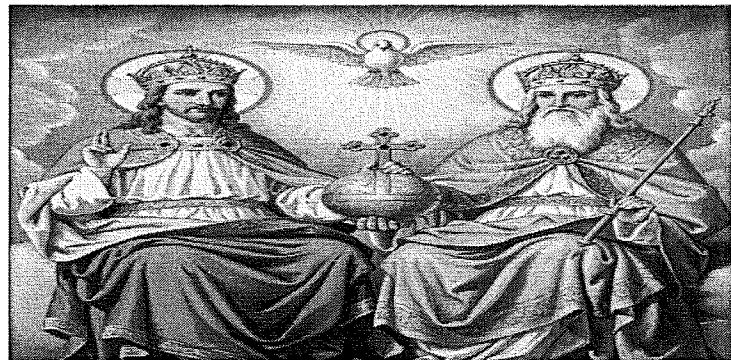

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As I mentioned in this space last week, next Sunday, June 18, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). The words "Body of Christ" have at least three important meanings. First, they refer to the reality of the incarnation. The great fact that God the Son became human, that he took on a human body. Second, these words signify that under the appearance of bread and wine in the Eucharist is the real presence of the Body of Christ. When we receive Communion we encounter the real Body and Blood of Christ. Finally, the Church is the Body of Christ. We are united to Christ as our head and to one another as members of His body. I find it very fitting that this Solemnity is the day designated in our diocese to (re) commission Ministers of Holy Communion. As we celebrate this (re) commissioning may we all remember that each of us as a member of the Church is called by God to build up the Body of Christ. Being a Minister of Communion is one way of doing that.

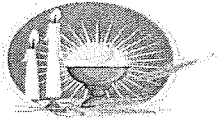

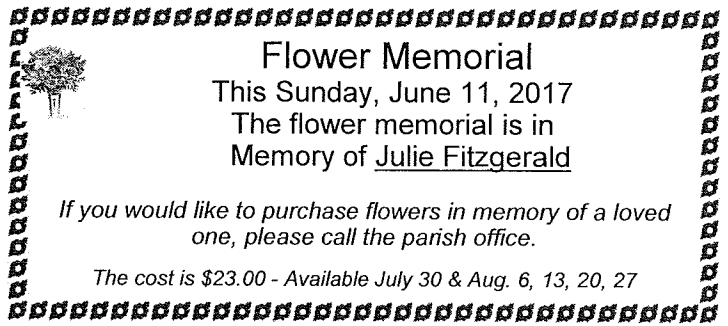
