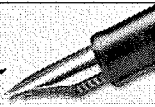
### Mission Statement

## From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

This coming Tuesday, July 4, we celebrate the United States of America's Declaration of Independence. There are several comments I am going to make about that celebration in this space today. First, the United States declared its independence from Great Britain in 1776. However, it required a war lasting more than 7 years for that declaration to become reality. "Declaring" something and accomplishing it are different. We make declarations such as "I want to follow Jesus Christ." We need to do the work to make those words reality. Second, most of us value our independence. One of the greatest challenges for many people as they experience various disabilities is to become dependent upon other people. The fact is that every one of us is, to various degrees, dependent upon others. Third, teaching history is not the priority in schools that it was when I was a boy. Today, much more emphasis is placed on science and math. I encourage adults to take some time to discuss with children what we are celebrating on July 4. Finally, one of our most basic freedoms is freedom of religion. This freedom is not only about the ability to worship as we choose within the confines of a church building but to live our values in the public square. As we observe Independence Day let us rejoice and also commit ourselves to maintaining the freedoms for which so many have sacrificed.

eyeglasses . Thank you for supporting this project.

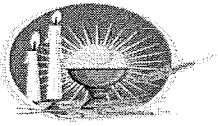
