## From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

A few weeks ago some friends of mine from Rhode Island were out here to visit and a week after that some friends from Minnesota stopped by. In both cases the husbands admired the grass and yard at Holy Family—they were not at St. Paul. I mentioned that I do not really pay attention to these things, I take them for granted. It is easy not to notice things around us. This has many implications. I mention it here especially in connection to the controversy about “monuments”. I was particularly struck by Bishop Doherty’s comment in the most recent issue of The Catholic Moment about the monument at the Tippecanoe Battlefield which notes the death of 32 “Americans” and of “Indians” as unknown. I have seen this monument multiple times and do not think I ever noticed this detail. I wonder if a native American would be so nonchalant about it. What we notice depends largely upon our point of view. We do not want to become so “politically correct” that we cannot say anything. At the same time being sensitive to others’ experiences and perspectives is a good thing.
