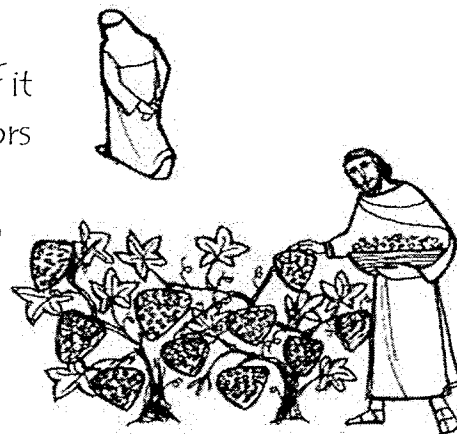

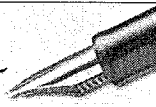
Mission Statement

From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Next Saturday, October 7, is the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. This feast was established to celebrate the victory of a European (Christian) naval force over a Turkish (Islamic) fleet which was attacking Europe at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. Before the battle Don Juan of Austria, the commander of the European fleet, ordered his sailors to pray the rosary. Many historians consider the triumph of the greatly outnumbered European fleet to be one of the most significant events in military history. There are three items I want to point out in particular about this event. First, conflict between the Islamic East and Christian West, which is much in the news now, is not new. It has been ongoing for over 13 centuries. Second, Don Juan was the illegitimate son of King Felipe II of Spain. In the society of his time this made him something of an outcast. It would have been striking to his contemporaries that God would have used such a man as His instrument. We need to be open to God working through unexpected people and situations. Third, praying the rosary was probably not the most practical military preparation for this battle. Prayer needs to be an important part of our lives at all times.

Our Lady of the Rosary

On October 7, the Roman Catholic Church celebrates the yearly feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was invoked on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe.

St. Paul Parish will have a living rosary (balloon rosary release). You can come to benediction at noon on Saturday. After, we will gather outside in front of the church and begin prayer at 12:15pm. All parishioners are invited to join in this powerful prayer! The prayer intentions are for all the tragedies around the world and for those who no longer practice the Faith, our youth, youth group, and our pastor.

Dear St. Paul Catholic Church

I would like to thank you for the recent donation of \$466.35 to Hands of Hope, a division of Family Service Society, Inc for the Flannery-Keal Home.

Your contribution could not be more appropriately timed as we are facing a significant gap in finances right now with grants not being received in a timely manner. So, not only is this gift a wonderful donation, it comes at a time when money is extremely tight, so a true God send!

In 2016, the Flannery-Keal Home was a safe haven for 124 women, two men and 75 children. The hotline staff answered 247 crisis calls, 25 lethality calls and 110 information calls.

On the prevention side, Hands of Hope Community Education staff presented information about domestic violence, sexual violence and stalking as well as healthy relationships, respect and conflict resolution to 8,047 elementary, junior high and high school students in each of the Grant County public schools as well as Lakeview Christian School and St. Paul Catholic School.
