Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday, November 26, is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King of the Universe. This is the last Sunday of the Church's Year. Next Sunday, we begin the Season of Advent and a new Church Year. As we end an old and begin a new year the Church focuses on the end of the world. This is obvious from the prayers and readings which we hear at Mass. I think that for many people the reality of the end of the world conjures up negative, even frightening images and thoughts. Let me suggest that we remember that the word "end" has a number of meanings. One of those is "finish line". If I am running a race approaching the finish line is something I desire, not fear. For us the finish line is Jesus Christ. What the Church really wants us to do at this time of the year is to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus Christ as the end, the goal, the finish line of our lives.
