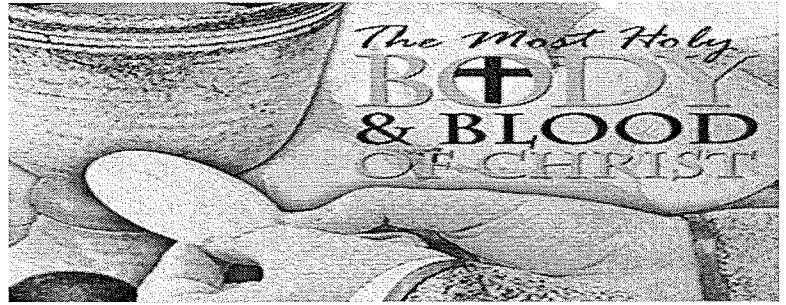

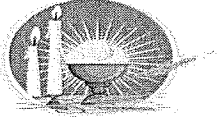

The Scriptures today remind us that “we, many though we are, are one body for we all partake of the one loaf.” How are we using our gifts of time and talent to build up the Body of Christ?

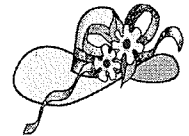
SCRIP

Think of using SCRIP as you do debit cards – ONLY instead of the bank making a profit on your expenditures, ST. PAUL SCHOLARSHIP FUND makes a profit between 2-15%. A portion of the profits from purchases of SCRIP can be assigned to a specific student enrolled in St. Paul School or all of the profit from purchases can go into the general scholarship fund.
