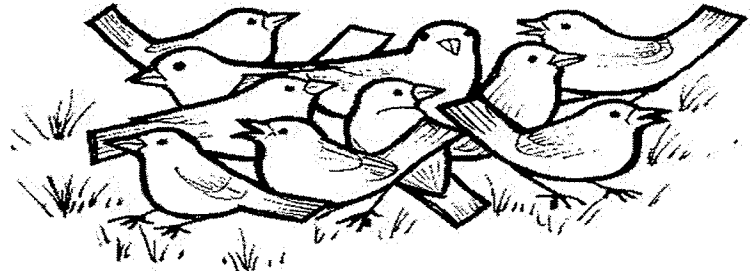

From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

This Coming Thursday, June 29, is The Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles. These two men were the leading figures in the first century of the Church. I often think of them as representing two different and essential aspects of the Church. Peter represents stability: the fact that the Church does not get caught up in whatever happens to be trendy at the moment. The very fact that Jesus nicknames His apostle Simon "Peter" "Rock" underlines this stability. On the other hand I consider Paul as embodying the adventurousness of the Church. Paul pushes the envelope. Without Paul Jesus' followers might very well have remained just a little group of Jews and not become a universal Church. I suspect it is difficult for most of us to appreciate how radical Paul's inclusion of Gentiles, non-Jews was. These two aspects of the Church can often be in tension. Peter and Paul had sharp disagreements (Galatians 2:11-14). Some of us probably feel more comfortable with the stability symbolized by St. Peter and are uncomfortable with change. Some of us may prefer the openness to the new of St. Paul. Let me suggest that both aspects are necessary for the Church. Part of being Catholic is living with the tension of "both and" instead of opting for an easy simplification.

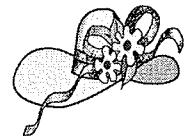
