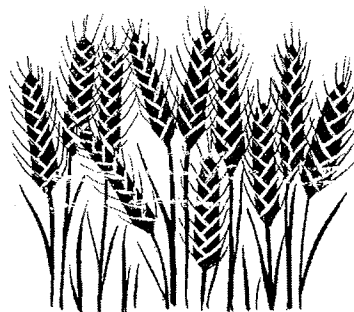

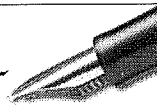
### Mission Statement

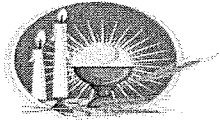
One of Those Organizations Is:

Several years ago we wanted the opportunity to reach out to the children of the community that have been affected by a negative life experience. We wanted these children to have a positive encounter with a law enforcement office. Each year with the assistance from Hands of Hope our lodge takes between 60 to 70 children to shop for clothing at a local department store (the past few years has been Meijer's). For some of these children this might be the only articles they get for Christmas. We conduct a fundraiser each year through phone solicitation to raise money for this event. We also, through the fundraiser, have an annual country concert at Marion High School around the same time as our Cops and Kids program.
