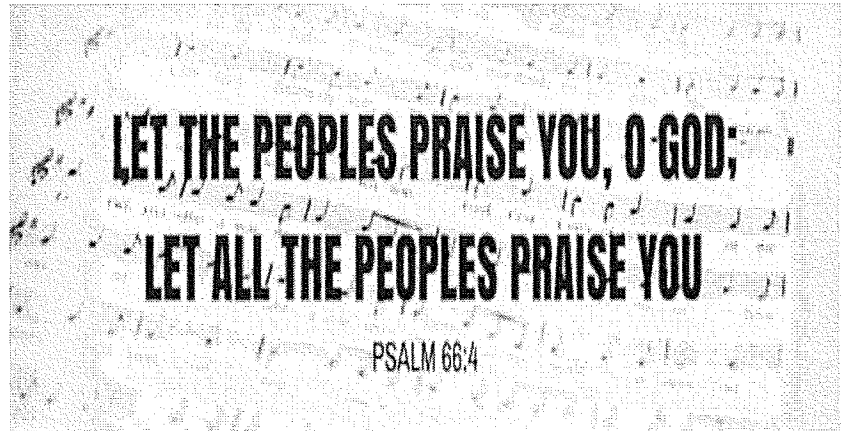

From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Most of us are probably aware of the racist violence which took place in Charlottesville, Virginia on Saturday, August 12. It is important to condemn all racial hatred and violence as contrary to our calling to be one in Christ and also our common humanity as descendants of Adam and Eve. It is necessary to acknowledge that racial animosity still exists in our country and throughout the world. At the same time we need to acknowledge that we have made great progress over the past 50 years. As someone old enough to remember well the civil rights movement of the 1960's we are far closer now to the fulfillment of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s dream that people be judged "not by the color of their skin but by the content of their character" than we were in 1963. It is possible to acknowledge that progress and also realize that the dream is not yet fully realized. As an old, white man I cannot fully appreciate the discrimination that some members of minorities still experience. Nonetheless I am sure that it does exist. May we both celebrate the progress of the past 50 years and continue our efforts to make the dream of oneness as children of God reality.

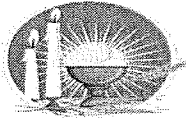

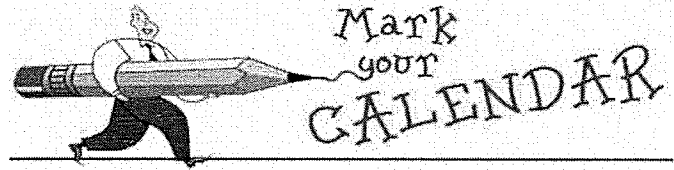
