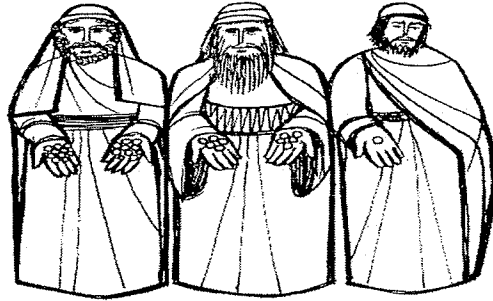

Dear Parishioners,

I am going to mention two upcoming events in this space today. First, this coming Thursday, November 23, is Thanksgiving Day. Not only is this a great American holiday, but it is also an opportunity for us to remember that giving thanks is central to our lives as Christians. The word "Eucharist" literally means "giving thanks". Therefore, for Catholics giving thanks is at the heart of our worship. We thank God for His countless gifts to us not only with words but also by using those gifts well. Mass at Holy Family on Thanksgiving Day will be at 8A.M. and at St. Paul at 10A.M. During the Mass at St. Paul we will, as we have done for many years, take up a special collection for the St. Martin Center. You are invited to bring non-perishable items or money which we will bring forward during the Preparation of the Offerings. Second, we will soon begin Advent. Even though Advent is not a penitential season it is a time to prepare to welcome Christ when He comes again in glory to judge the living and the dead. Part of that preparation is celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I will spend a significant part of Advent going to other parishes of the Muncie Deanery to help with their Communal Penance Services. Our Communal Penance Services will be on Thursday, December 14. The one at St. Paul will be at 2P.M. and at Holy Family at 7P.M. I encourage everyone to take advantage of this opportunity to prepare for the future arrival of Christ.
