The schedule for Ash Wednesday is elsewhere in this bulletin. Let me also mention that our Lenten Communal Penance Services will be on Thursday, March 22. The one at St. Paul will be at 2P.M. and the service at Holy Family will be at 7P.M. I encourage everyone to take advantage of this opportunity to celebrate God's mercy.
