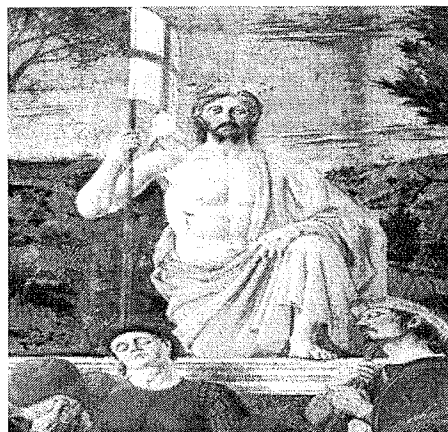

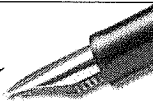
Mission Statement

From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Alleluia! Alleluia! He is risen as He promised. Alleluia! Today and throughout the 50 days of the Easter Season we celebrate God's victory over Sin and Death. God made flesh experienced in the profoundest way possible the reality of evil. He endured humiliation and suffering and rose victorious from the Dead. This victory is not that of one man alone, but rather a victory in which each of us can share. If we accept our part of the cross we are promised that we will also share the resurrection. Sacramentally we begin to share the cross when we are baptized. Through baptism we die with Jesus Christ and are raised to new life with Him. This link explains why Easter is so intimately connected with baptism. Throughout the Easter Season we will celebrate the sprinkling rite in place of the penitential rite on Sundays. May these days of the Easter Season deepen our commitment to our baptismal promises so that we might receive the fulfillment of God's promise of eternal life. Let me also mention three other items in this space today. First, next Sunday April 8 during the 12:30p.m. Mass we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Second, on the Third Sunday of Easter, April 15 some of our fellow parishioners will receive Holy Communion for the first time. At Holy family this will take place during the Vigil Mass at 5p.m. and at St. Paul during the Mass at 12:30p.m. Please remember to pray for our fellow parishioners as they prepare to receive these sacraments. Third, on Monday, April 9 we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. The actual date for this Solemnity is March 25, however, this year that date fell on Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion and no feast can be celebrated during Holy Week or the Octave of Easter. Therefore the first available date to celebrate the Annunciation will be April 9. The fact that we celebrate this Solemnity more than two weeks after its actual date indicates how important this Solemnity is. More about that next week.

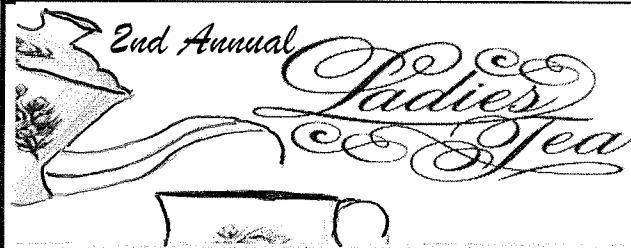

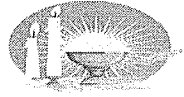
